

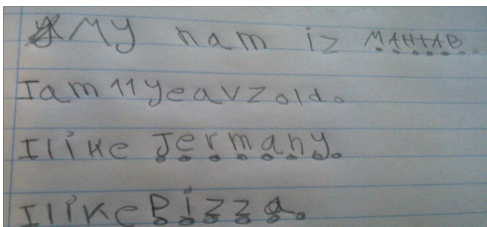


# NFEC NEWSLETTER SAMOS

“Looking at the sky I made this picture using colours that makes me feel calm, warm and at peace.”

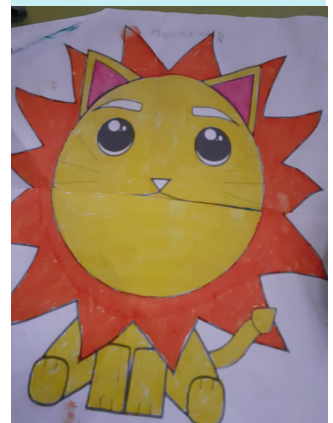
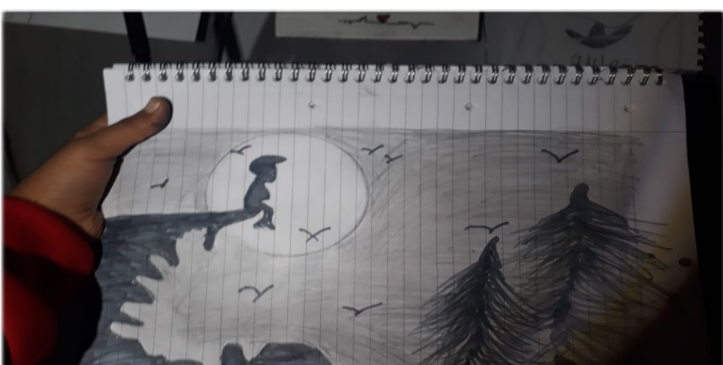


**This is Mahtab, she’s 10 years old.**

Tabasom, 6 years old. "My dream house".



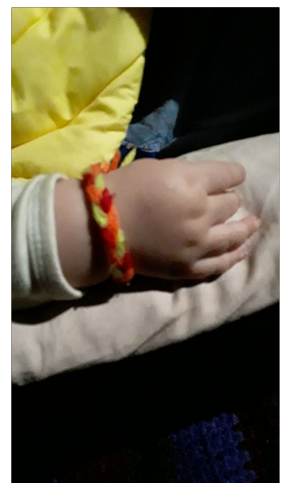
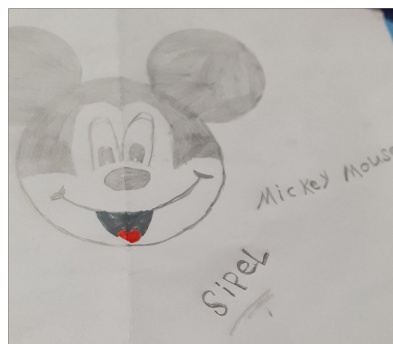
Tabasom's bracelet.
