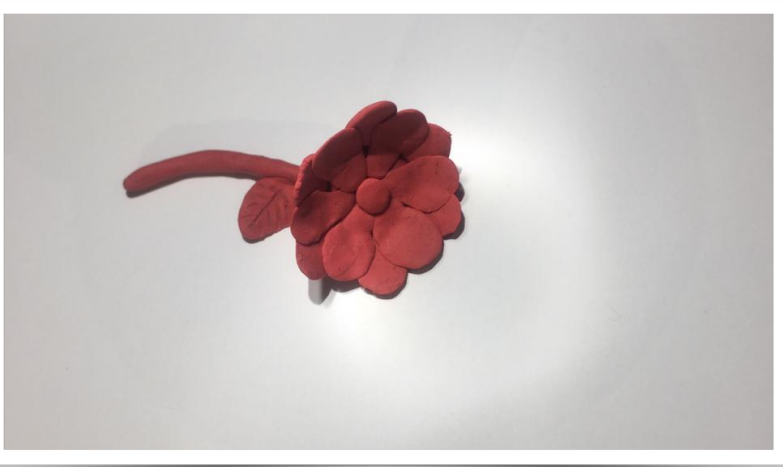




NFEC NEWSLETTER

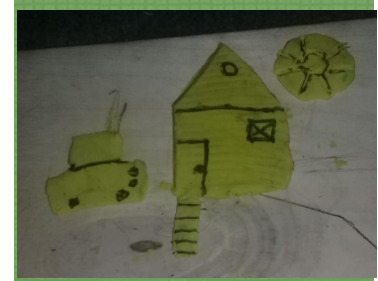
Roghaye_Zahra_Zainab, 10 years old.
