Social scientists staff PRAKSIS Open Day Center and support visitors psychosocially; a medical doctor and a nurse provide primary medical care and medicine and if needed, referrals to hospitals or other medical services. Due to its holistic approach,

PRAKSIS Open Day Center extends an array of services to its homeless visitors: psychological support, job counselling, laundry, showers and clothing. It is a safe space to rest and have a coffee and a snack.

More specifically, it provides on a daily basis (24/7):

- Safe place to rest (heated / air-conditioned)
- Showers
- Hygiene kits
- Laundry service
- Clothing and shoes
- Coffee, tea, snacks
- Safekeeping of personal belongings
- Primary medical care and medicine
- Individual or group meetings with specialised staff to identify the needs and the solutions to manage them
- Interconnection with other Agencies (psychological support, food, accommodation, health issues, social and job (re)integration – when needed).

Moreover, under the principle of the timeless voluntary offering, our beneficiaries can access at PRAKSIS Open Day Center for the Homeless in Athens:

- Clothes and shoes space – the Cloakroom
- Lending Library
- Cinema club
- Children Playroom
